**Flu Shots Began October 1**

The Fulton County Department of Health & Wellness began offering flu shots October 1st at twelve health centers throughout the County. Shots cost \$20, but will be made available to residents regardless of ability to pay. Individuals at high risk for influenza are especially encouraged to be vaccinated. High risk groups include adults over age 50, individuals with certain chronic health conditions, children over 6 months, individuals in nursing homes and other group care facilities, health care workers, caregivers of children under age 5, and women who will be pregnant during flu season.
