Dear Friends in Fulton County,

I wish to inform you of two important matters that will be considered by the Fulton County Board of Commissioners on Wednesday, July 2, 2008.

First, the Commission will consider the release of tax funds collected in unincorporated areas of Fulton County in 2006 and 2007 prior to the creation of the Cities of Johns Creek, Milton and Chattahoochee Hill Country. The Board debated this matter at the June 18th meeting, but held action until July 2nd for additional review by County Management. Please contact all Commissioners and urge them to act favorably to release the funds due to the new cities (and existing cities that annexed unincorporated areas) in Fulton County pursuant to the terms of Senate Bill 154 that was passed by the Georgia General Assembly in 2008.

Secondly, the Commission will consider two proposed changes to the Library Facility Master Plan. The Board of Commissioners approved the scope of this facility master plan on March 19, 2008 and received associated cost information on May 21, 2008. However, there are two remaining issues to be considered before we may act on a resolution to place the Library Bond Referendum on the November 4, 2008 ballot for Fulton County voter approval. Both of these items have been presented subsequent to the March 19th approval of the plan scope: the proposed sale of the Buckhead Branch Library property and the construction of a proposed new Central Library. Both of these matters could have a significant impact on the approved facility master plan, which has gone through years of extensive study, review, and public comment. Implementation, timing and taxpayer cost to pay for a revised master plan could be quite different from the original plan. I encourage you to attend the Commission meeting or view the meeting via broadcast or live stream on the internet, and to make your comments to the Commissioners prior to or during the July 2nd meeting. The Board of Commissioners must act on the final Library Bond Resolution no later than July 16th to legally place the matter on the November 4th ballot.
